The Governor's commerce tax continues to be a hassle for marketers, some rules and regulations are still in flux. Some marketers are charging a surcharge to their customers to try to recover some of the tax. The association is working with the Department of Tax to try to lessen the filing burden for companies reporting under 4 million in gross receipts.

Governor Sandoval has appointed John Saxon as our representative on the Petroleum Claims Board. John replaces John Haycock who served as chairman for more than 26 years. The board reviews and approves all claims made against the petroleum fund.

The Big Dogs Shootout will again be in Las Vegas, May 19-20 at the Red Rock Hotel & Casino and Bear's Best for Golf. The Big Dogs format has worked well in Nevada and we are grateful for the industry support the event receives.

Expect Clark and Washoe County fuel index tax rate to increase another 4 to 6 cents/per gallon on July 1st.
