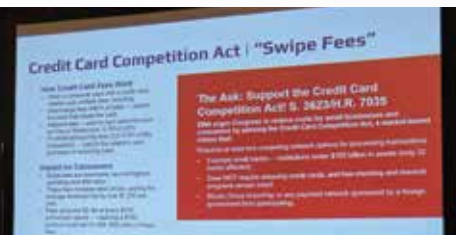
Gearing up for the 2026 Election Cycle

2026 Legislative Session Wrap up

Utah Fuel Export Tax

- HJM12 – Utah Fuel Tax – To express the opposition of the Idaho Legislature to any proposal by the State of Utah to impose an export tax on transportation fuels sold outside its borders.
- HCR34 – Bear River Compact, Asserts Idaho's water rights
- H943 - Tax Incentives for Pipelines

PSTF / DEQ / Lottery

- PSTF – Code Clean Up (S1265 LAW)
- Bulk lottery ticket purchases (H504 LAW)

Retail/ Vape/SNAP

- Kratom regulation (S1282 / S1418 – Failed in the Senate 15/20)
- Vape regulation and taxes (Not introduced)
- SNAP – Candy & Soda H903/H938)
- Crypto Kiosks (S1333 / S1359 Vetoeed)
- Penny Shortage/Cash Rounding (S1329 / S1350 LAW)
