### Inside the Beltway

This week Speaker Mike Johnson (R-LA) met with transportation industry lobbyists to discuss the surface transportation bill. Participants in the meeting reportedly left with the impression that the bill is on the speaker's radar, though a floor vote is still up in the air. Despite the positive momentum, the BUILD America 250 Act ([H.R.8870](#)) still faces several significant hurdles, particularly regarding the funding amount and specific fees included in the legislation. Fiscal conservatives have expressed concern over the bill's high price tag and the projected need to transfer approximately \$164 billion from the Treasury to keep the Highway Trust Fund solvent. Additionally, the legislation's progress is hindered by a tight legislative calendar; the current authorization expires on September 30, and only four legislative weeks remain before the August recess. With the Senate yet to produce its own bill text and midterm elections approaching in October, the window for passing the package on time is rapidly closing.

On appropriations news the House Appropriations Committee has been churning through FY27 bills on an aggressive schedule. The full House passed the FY27 Agriculture bill 213-210 last week, and the committee has advanced the FY27 Labor-HHS-Education bill 34-28. The committee also approved the FY27 Transportation-HUD bill 34-27. On the other hand, the Senate Appropriations Committee has scrapped markups for the second week in a row as FY27 negotiations stall. Chair Susan Collins (R-ME) said Democrats "are not willing to work with us," while Vice Chair Patty Murray said the two sides remain "miles apart" on a topline agreement. All of the bills scheduled for full committee markup this week, Agriculture, Legislative Branch, and Commerce-Justice-Science bills are listed as "to be rescheduled." Many are already pessimistic about the deadline, and a continuing resolution at FY26 levels before September 30 seems likely, though not certain.

### **Court Permits EMA to Intervene in Landmark Case on Legality of Tailpipe Emissions and Other Rules Regulating Greenhouse Gases**

On June 9, 2026, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit granted EMA's motion to intervene in *American Public Health Association, et al v. U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA")*, in support of EPA's repeal of its so-called "Endangerment Finding." The Endangerment Finding (made in 2010) represented EPA's judgment at the time that carbon dioxide emissions endanger the public health and welfare, and it stood for many years as the foundation for all EPA rules governing greenhouse gas emissions. EPA repealed the Endangerment Finding, effective April 20, 2026, and with it, the rules mandating rapid and

widespread electrification of the transportation sector. This includes the rules governing greenhouse gas emissions from passenger cars and light, medium, and heavy-duty trucks. A group of petitioners, however, are now challenging the repeal in an effort to reinstate the preexisting tailpipe emissions standards.

EMA intervened in the case to support the findings made by EPA to repeal the Endangerment Finding, that: (i) greenhouse gases do not endanger public health or welfare through local or regional exposure and; and (ii) under the “major questions doctrine,” EPA’s electrification mandates raise questions of major economic and political significance that can be resolved only by Congress through a grant of clear legislative authority, which it did not give to EPA. How the Court decides these issues will determine the fate of electric vehicle mandates and the impact they would have on demand for liquid fuels and the businesses of EMA members. It is highly likely that the Court’s final decision will make its way to the Supreme Court for ultimate resolution.
